 a State on south line of said section 11 at its intersection with the shore of Long Lake at high water mark, from which an elm 18 inches in diameter bears S. 112° W. distant 87 lks. and a 2.50 c. 16 inches in diameter bears S. 94° E. distant 82 lks. Thence east along said line 042' to a post from which an elm 20 inches in dia bears south 112° W. distant 98 links, Thence S. 112° W. 120' to a post, Thence south 462' to a post, Thence S. 53° W. 253 1/2' to a post standing on the shore of Long Lake at high water mark from which a 13. Oak 16 inches in dia bears S. 152° W. distant 82 lks. and a poplar 16 inches in dia bears 1° 56' distant 82 lks. 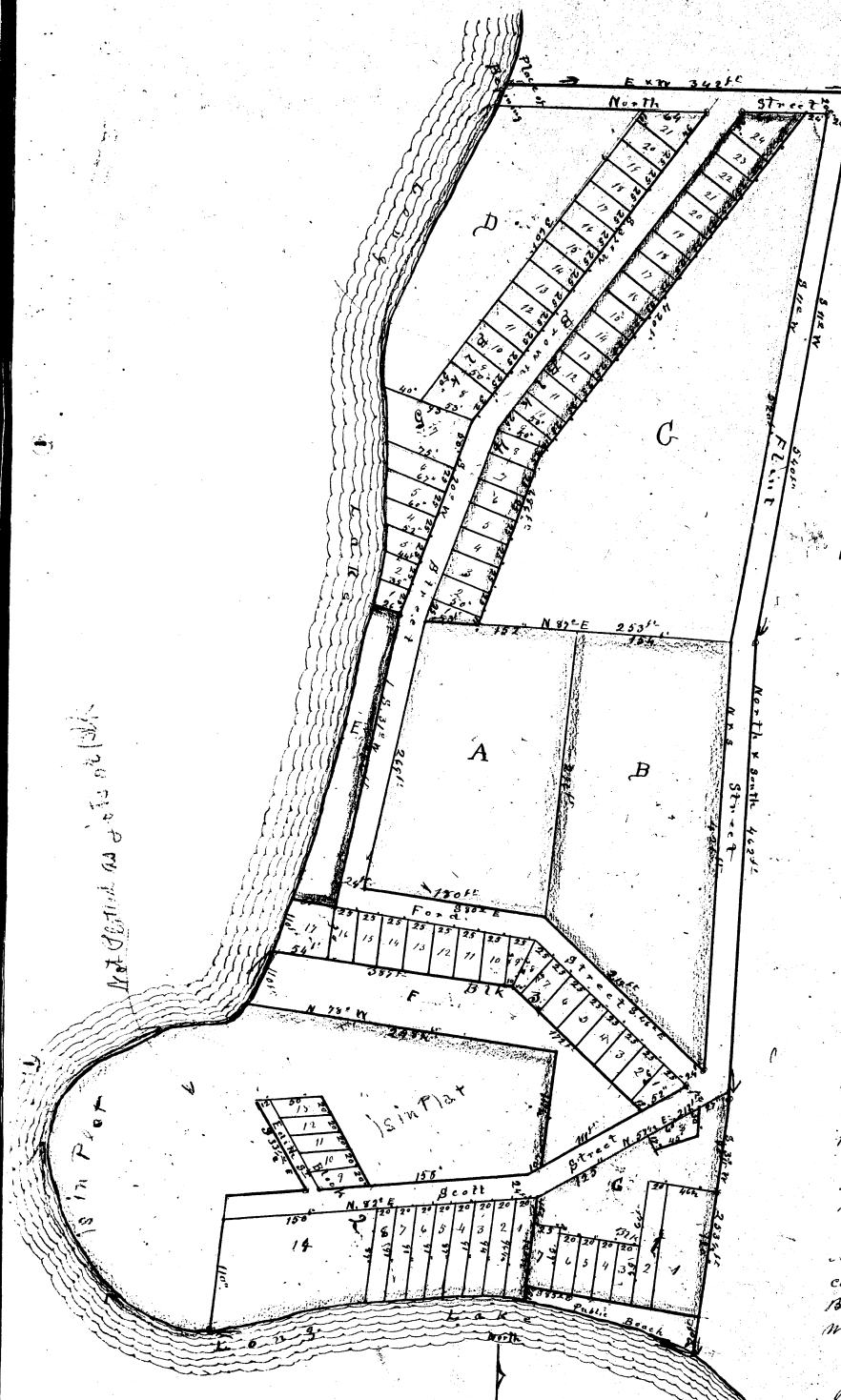

NOTICE OF RESOLUTION

At a meeting of the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Genesee, Michigan, held on the 21st day of October, 1990, at which time a quorum of the members was present, the following resolution was unanimously adopted by vote taken by yeas and nays and entered at large upon the record of said Board.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, we, as said Board, are in receipt of a written petition signed by certain freeholders in the Township of Fenton, Genesee County, Michigan, praying for the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of a portion of street; and,

WHEREAS, the portion of street is described as follows: All that portion of WEST STREET being 20 feet in width and extending e 1/4 ly approximately 220 feet, more or less, from the east shore line of Lake Fenton (long center line of said lake as shown on the plat of said lake in Section 11, Township of Fenton, Genesee County, Michigan. Said segment of street is abutted on the south by lot 21 and lot D of aforesaid plat and on the north by certain metes and bounds parcels.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at 10:30 a.m., December 3, 1990, at 211 West Oakley Street, Flint, Michigan, to hear objections to this proposed abandonment and discontinuance; and,

WHEREAS, there were no objections heard to the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of this street; and,

WHEREAS, it is the belief of this Board that the best interests of the public will be served by the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of this segment of street and at this time a more valuable use for the property is possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That in the best interests of the public welfare, the segment of street heretofore described be and the same are hereby absolutely abandoned and discontinued as a public street, subject to the reservation of an easement for public utility purposes in accordance with the provisions of Section 237 of Act No. 288 of Michigan Public Acts of 1977 and the same be placed on the assessment rolls for the purpose of taxation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a notice of this determination be published in the Genesee County Register of Deeds for three consecutive weeks in Genesee County, once each week for three consecutive weeks: that certified copies of this resolution be served on the Michigan Department of Transportation, the Plat Division of Department of Commerce of the State of Michigan, and the Clerk of Fenton Township; that Consumers Power Company, Michigan Bell Telephone, and the U.S. Postal Service be notified by letter of this determination and that a copy of this resolution be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Genesee, Michigan.

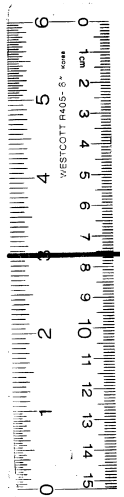
