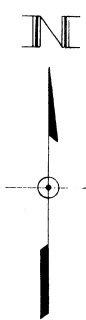

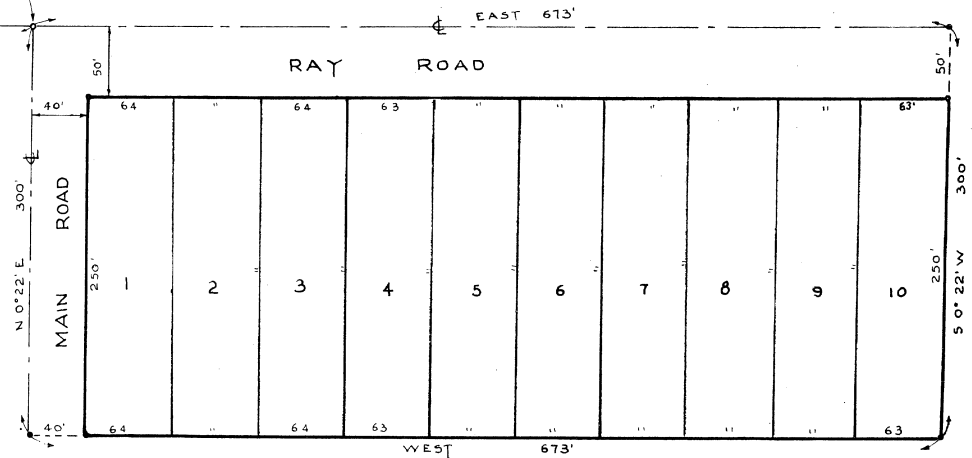
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE
