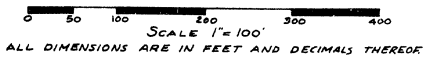


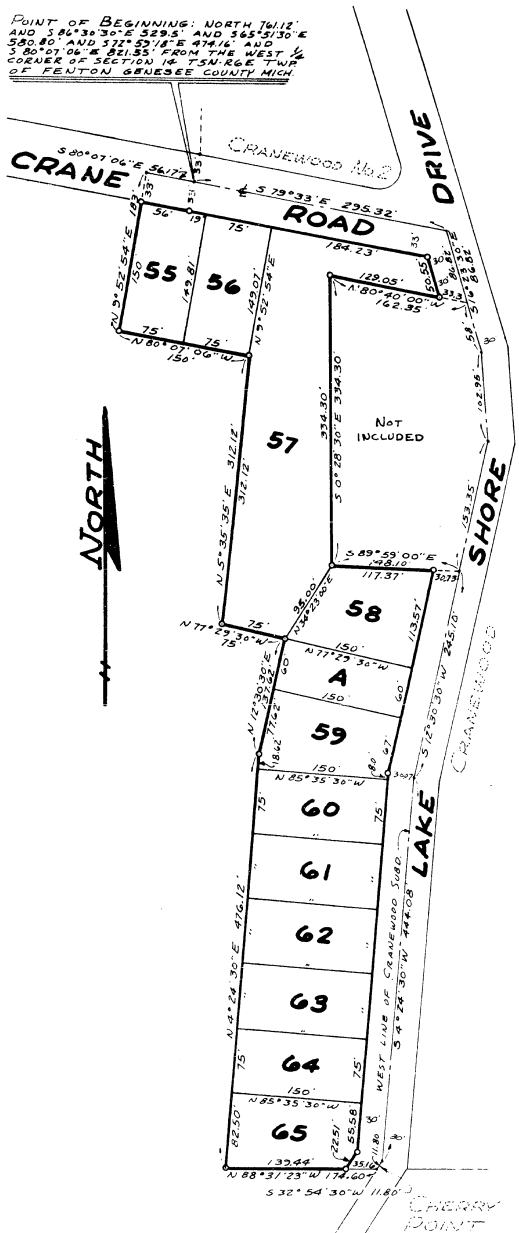
GOLDEN SHORES NO. 2
