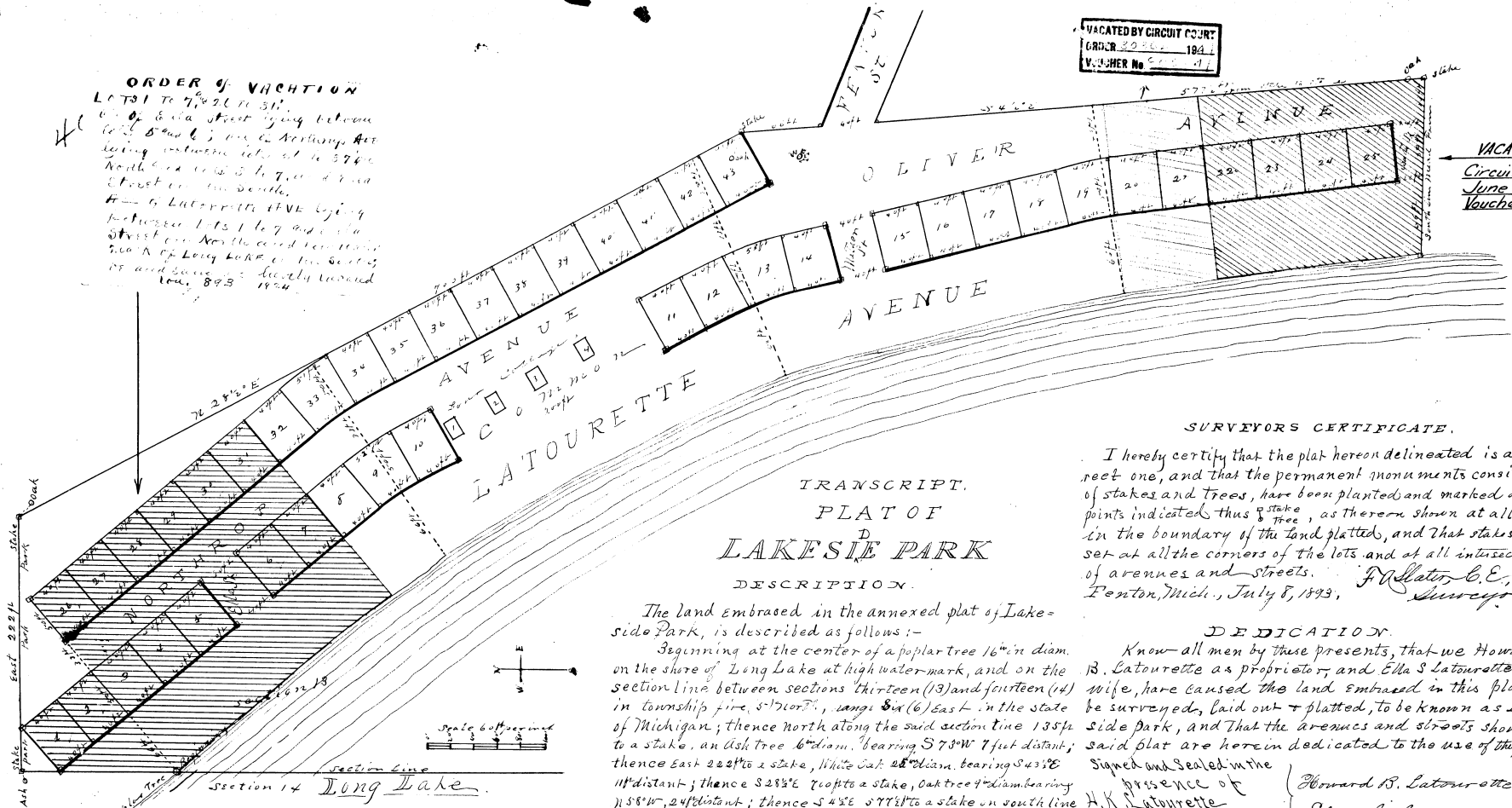

TRANSCRIPT.
 PLAT OF
LAKESIDE PARK
 DESCRIPTION.

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Lakeside Park, is described as follows:-

Beginning at the center of a poplar tree 16" in diam on the shore of Long Lake at high water mark, and on the section line between sections thirteen (13) and fourteen (14) in township five, S 17 north, range six (6) east, in the state of Michigan; thence north along the said section line 135 ft to a stake, an ash tree 6" diam, bearing S 73° W 7 feet distant; thence East 222 ft to a stake, White Oak 2 1/2" diam, bearing S 43° E 11' distant; thence S 28 1/2° E 70 ft to a stake, Oak tree 7" diam bearing N 58° W, 24 ft distant; thence S 45° E 57 ft to a stake on south line of land known as Meads Farm, White Oak 20" diam bearing a north of distant; thence west along the said boundary 149 ft to shore of Long Lake; thence north along the shore of said lake to place of beginning; containing 5 1/2 acres more or less, being a part of the southwest fractional quarter of the northwest fractional quarter of section thirteen (13), township five (5) north, range (6) six east.

NOTICE OF RESOLUTION

At a meeting of The Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Genesee, Michigan, held at 211 West Oakley Street, Flint, Michigan 48503, on the 5th day of January, 1993, at which time a quorum of the members was present, the following resolution was unanimously adopted by vote taken by yeas and nays and entered at large upon the record of said Board.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, we, as said Board, are in receipt of a written petition signed by certain freeholders of the Township of Fenton, Genesee County, Michigan, praying for the petition for the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of a portion of NORTHRUP AVENUE; and,

WHEREAS, the portion of street is described as follows: All that portion of NORTHRUP AVENUE (Lakeside Landing) being 565.50 feet, more or less, in length, as the recorded plat of Lakeside Park (Liber 1, page 34), lying within the following described closed traverse: Beg. at the East plat line, which is the SW corner of Fenton Avenue, said point being S 28 deg. 30' E 700 feet; th. S 4 deg 30' E 106 feet from NW corner of the aforementioned plat; th. Wly to NE cor of lot 15; th. N and NW'ly to East cor of lot 7 (same being North cor of lot 8); th. NW'ly 33 feet to S corner of lot 31 (same being West cor of lot 32), th. SE'ly to South cor of lot 43; th. E 28.5 deg. N to East cor of lot 43; th. S 4 deg 30' E 106 feet to place of beg., Section 13, Fenton Township, Genesee County, Michigan. Said segment of street being abutted on the West by lots 8 thru 14 inclusive and four cottages common and on the East by lots 32 thru 43 inclusive and metes and bounds parcels lying south of lot 43 and north of Fenton Avenue in the aforementioned plat.; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on December 15, 1992, at 10:30 a.m., 1992, at 10:30 a.m., at 211 West Oakley Street, Flint, Michigan, to hear objections to this proposed abandonment and discontinuance; and,

WHEREAS, there were no objections heard to the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of this street; and,

WHEREAS, it is the belief of this Board that the best interests of the public will be served by the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of this segment of street and at this time a more valuable use for the property is possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That in the best interests of the public welfare, the street hereinbefore described be and the same are hereby absolutely abandoned and discontinued as a public street, subject to the reservation of an easement for public utility purposes within the right-of-way of said street as provided under Section 257 of Act No. 288 of Michigan Public Acts of 1967 and the same be placed on the assessment rolls for the purpose of taxation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a notice of this determination be published in The Flint-Genesee County Legal News, a newspaper of general circulation in Genesee County, once each week for three consecutive weeks; that certified copies of this resolution be served on the Michigan Department of Transportation, the Plat Division of Department of Commerce of the State of Michigan, and the Clerk of Fenton Township, that Consumers Power Company, Michigan Bell Telephone Company, and the U.S. Postal Service be notified of this abandonment by letter; and that a copy of this resolution be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Genesee, Michigan.

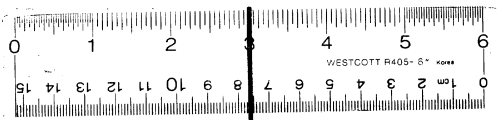

At a meeting of the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Genesee, Michigan, held at 211 West Oakley Street, Flint, Michigan, on the 11th day of July, 1963, the following resolution was passed, to-wit: That the members were present at the following time, to-wit: a quorum of the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Genesee, Michigan, was taken by yeas and nays and entered at large on the records of said Board.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, we, as said Board, are in receipt of a written petition signed by certain freeholders in the Township of Fenton, Genesee County, Michigan, praying for the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of portions of public streets, to-wit:

WHEREAS, we, as the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Genesee, Michigan, are of the opinion that portions of certain dedicated streets in the Township of Fenton, Genesee County, Michigan, should be abandoned and discontinued as public highways; and

WHEREAS, the subject streets are described as follows: Lakehurst Avenue, a portion of the W. fractional quarter of Section 13, Township of Fenton, Genesee County, Michigan, to the extension of the South Line of Lot 20 in aforesaid plat; also, Miller Street, in the aforesaid plat from the West Line of said Lot 14 and 15 of said plat; to the extension of the West Line of said Lot 14 and 15 of said plat; to the extension

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, on the 11th day of July, 1963, in the County of Genesee, Michigan, to this proposed abandonment and discontinuance; and

WHEREAS, no objections to aforesaid proposed abandonment were made at this hearing; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of this Board that the best interests of the public will be served by the absolute abandonment and discontinuance of those streets and at this time a more valuable use for the property is possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in the best interests of the public and the best interests of the County of Genesee, Michigan, the portions of streets hereinabove described are hereby absolutely abandoned as public streets, subject to the rights of maintain existing utility structures, and the same be placed on the assessment rolls for the purpose of taxation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a notice of this determination be published in the Flint-Genesee County Legal News, a newspaper of general circulation in Genesee County once each week for three consecutive weeks and that certified copies of this resolution be mailed to the following persons, to-wit: the County General, the Clerk of Fenton Township, also that Consumers Power Company, Michigan Bell Telephone Company and the Flint Federal Post Office be notified of this abandonment by letter and that said resolution be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County of Genesee, Michigan.

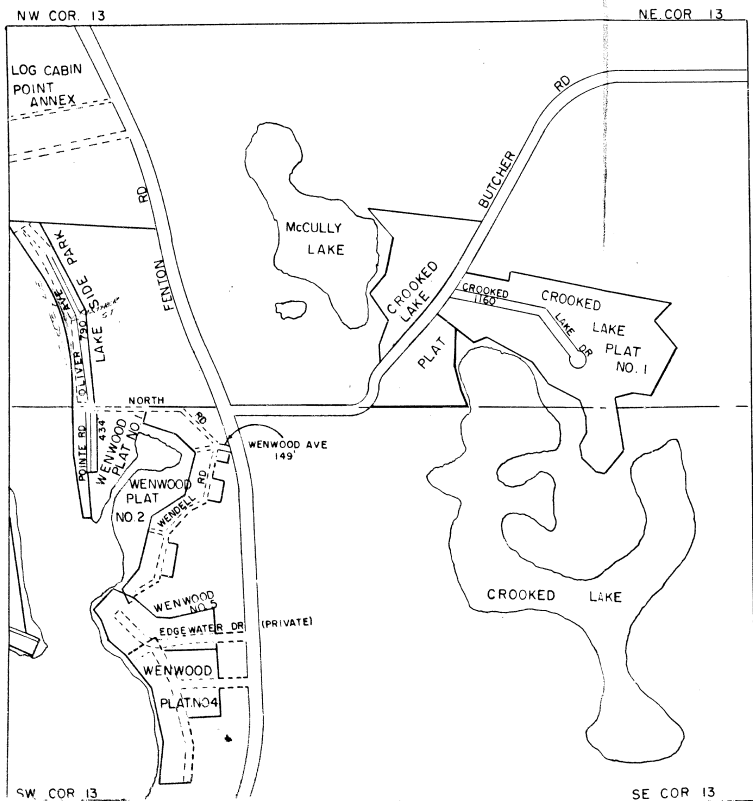
