 of Mich. as surveyed by A. E. Wetmore!

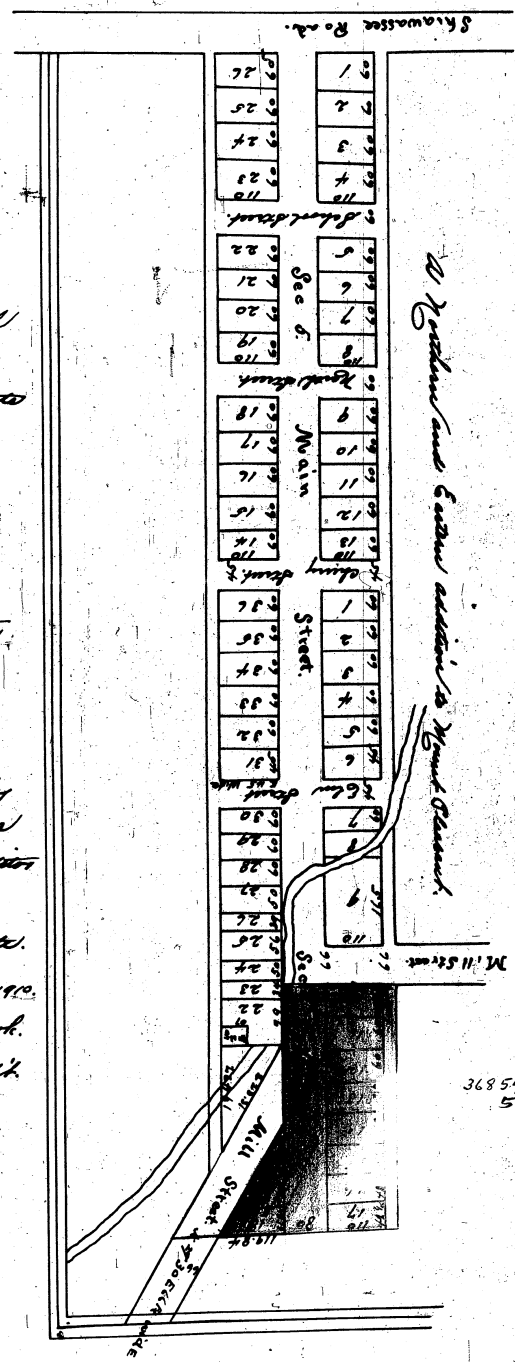
