**DESCRIPTION**

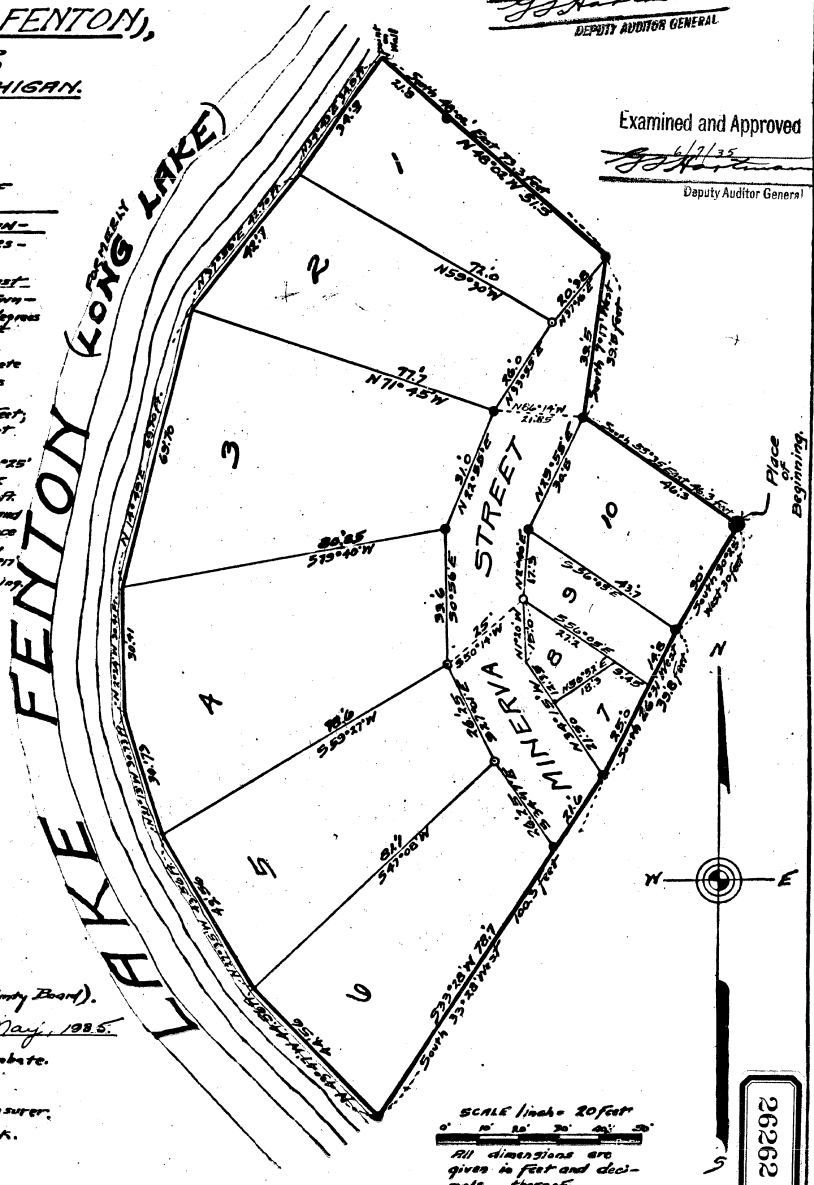
The lands embraced in the annexed plat of "SUPERVISOR'S PLAT NO. 21" (CEDAR POINT, LAKE FENTON), FENTON TOWNSHIP, GENESSEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN is described as follows:-  
 FROM A CONCRETE MONUMENT on the West line of "Mon-ka-Mou-ka Beach", Fenton Township, Genesee County, Michigan, lying South 3 degrees West 125 feet from the North-West Corner of Lot No. 63 in said "Beach" and North 24 degrees 15 minutes East 65 feet from a similar concrete monument, RUNNING THENCE South 53 degrees 57 minutes West 235.5 feet;  
 THENCE North 82 degrees 53 minutes West 315.6 feet;  
 THENCE North 53 degrees 25 minutes West 54 feet for a place of beginning.  
 THENCE FROM SAID PLACE OF BEGINNING South 30°25' West 30 feet; THENCE South 26°31' West 338 feet; THENCE South 33°20' West 100.30 feet; THENCE N 43°47' W 456 ft. and thence N 27°35' W 43.56 ft. and thence N 17°15' W 30.73 ft. and thence N 2°24' W 304 ft. and thence N 49°45' E 63.70 ft. and thence N 37°56' E 42.70 ft. and thence N 34°43' E 34.5 ft. along Easterly Shore of Lake Fenton; THENCE S 10°02' E 73.30 ft. Thence South 7°11' West 33.50 ft.; Thence South 55°25' East 46.30 ft. to place of beginning.

CONCRETE MONUMENT FIRST MENTIONED ABOVE on West line of "Mon-ka-Mou-ka Beach" lies from the East 1/4 Corner of Fractional Section 11, T.5N. R.6E, Genesee County, Michigan, RUNNING WEST along 1/4 line 1553 feet and thence following the Westerly Boundary line of said "Mon-ka-Mou-ka Beach" North 21 degrees West 282 feet and thence North 14 degrees West 186.5 feet and thence North 6 degrees West 174 feet and thence North 6 degrees 45 minutes West 151.5 feet and thence North 3 degrees West 150 feet and thence North 14 degrees West 61.33 feet and thence North 23 degrees 45 minutes West 64.33 feet and thence North 33 degrees West 69.75 feet and thence North 43 degrees 30 minutes West 100 feet and thence North 60 degrees West 100 feet and thence North 72 degrees 30 minutes West 100 feet and thence North 82 degrees West 50 feet and thence North 2 degrees 15 minutes East 235 feet.
