

**DESCRIPTION.** The land embraced in the annexed plat of Silverlake is described as follows: Commencing at a Pt. 28 1/8 Chains East of 4 post in line Bol. Secs. 21+28 of T5N of R6E. And from thence East along line Bol. said Secs. 21+28, 263 1/2 feet; Thence S. 61 1/2 E along center of highway 1259 feet; Thence S 28 1/2 W perpendicular to highway 97 feet; Thence N. 61 1/2 W. parallel with highway 1166 feet; Thence S. 73 1/2 W 935 feet; Thence S. 28 1/2 W. perpendicular to highway 792 feet; Thence N. 61 1/2 W. parallel with highway 394 feet; Thence N. 28 1/2 E perpendicular to highway 264 feet; Thence N. 61 1/2 W. 143 1/2 feet; Thence West parallel with Sec. line 132 feet; Thence North perpendicular to Sec. line 894 feet; Thence West parallel with Sec. line 132 feet; Thence North perpendicular to Sec. line 163 feet to place of beginning  
Wit. W. Oak 12' South 35 feet
