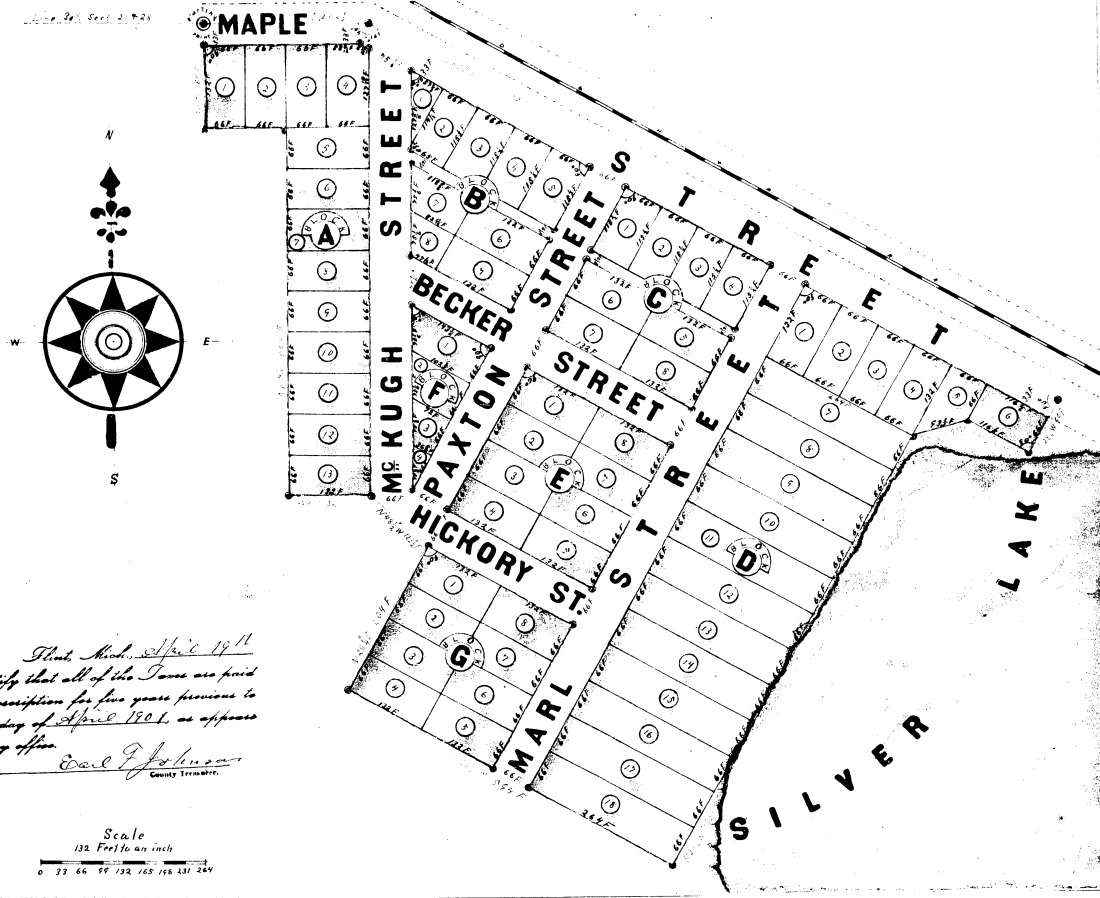

DESCRIPTION. The land embraced in the annexed plat of Silverlake is described as follows: Commencing at a Pt. 2815 Chains East of 1/4 post in line Bet. Secs. 21+28 of T.5N of R. 6E. And from thence East along line Bet. said Secs. 21+28, 262 1/2 feet; Thence S. 61 1/2 E along center of highway 1289 feet; Thence S. 28 1/2 W perpendicular to highway 98 feet; Thence N. 61 1/2 W, parallel with highway 116 1/2 feet; Thence S. 73 1/2 W 93 1/2 feet; Thence S. 28 1/2 W perpendicular to highway 792 feet; Thence N. 61 1/2 W, parallel with highway 854 feet; Thence N. 28 1/2 E perpendicular to highway 264 feet; Thence N. 61 1/2 W, 123 1/2 feet; Thence West parallel with Sec. line 132 feet; Thence North perpendicular to Sec. line 844 feet; Thence West parallel with sec. line 132 feet. Thence North perpendicular to Sec. line 165 feet to place of beginning W. 7. W. Oak 12 South 35 feet
