

**PUBLIC NOTICE
CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON
BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS
JANUARY 10, 2005**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday January 10, 2005 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the Agenda as amended.
3. Approved invoices for payment.
4. Authorized additional legal work to file a motion for reconsideration with the Michigan Court of Appeals with respect to their opinion in the LJS Partnership vs. Fenton Township lawsuit.
5. Placed a temporary moratorium on all rezoning applications and site plan applications until April 4, 2005.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2005-01, recommending approval of the transfer of an existing Class C Liquor License with Entertainment Permit from Head 2 Head, LLC to LHH of Michigan, Inc.
7. Postponed to 3/21/05 the second reading of a proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcel 06-02-400-019 from R-4 to PUD.
8. Adopted Ordinance No. 632, an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcels 06-07-400-002 and 06-08-300-015 from AG to R-3.
9. Approved a Summer Tax Collection Agreement with the Linden Community School District.
10. Approved a Summer Tax Collection Agreement with the Genesee Intermediate School District.
11. Adopted a Public Notices policy.
12. Schedule a public hearing for January 24, 2005 to accept public input on potential local road improvement projects for 2005.
13. Adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
