BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS
MARCH 7, 2005

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday March 7, 2005 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the Agenda as presented.
3. Approved invoices for payment.
4. Conducted the first reading of a proposed amendment to Group Health Insurance Ordinance No. 461.
5. Adopted a proclamation designating Sunday May 1, 2005 as Law Day.
6. Schedule a public hearing for March 21, 2005 to consider the application of Thompson I.G., LLC to transfer an existing Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificate from Atwood Mobile Products, Inc.
7. Authorized the Township to take over the responsibility of issuing electrical, plumbing and mechanical permits and the conducting the related inspections.
8. Authorized the creation of a part-time student employee position, and to authorize the Township Supervisor and Township Clerk to approve the hiring of the candidate selected to fill the position.
9. Declined the request of Mr. Sam Ragnone to amend the Consent Judgment from the LJS Partnership vs. Fenton Township lawsuit for the purpose of approving an alternate development site plan for the property.
10. Adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
