**BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS**  
**JUNE 20, 2005**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday June 20, 2005 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Troop 111 Boy Scouts Brandon Thomas and Nick Allen led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Approved invoices for payment.
4. Adopted Resolution No. 2005-13 and No. 2005-14, approving Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificates for Paragon Manufacturing Corporation for new equipment.
5. Tabled the second reading of a proposed amendment to the Fenton Township Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcels 06-13-100-007 and 06-12-300-013 from R-M and R-3 to PUD.
6. Adopted Ordinance No. 643, an amendment to the Fenton Township Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcel 06-09-300-022 from AG to R-3.
7. Defeated a motion to adopt a proposed Off Road Vehicle Ordinance.
8. Conducted the first reading of four proposed Zoning Ordinance text amendments.
9. Established a two week deadline for the removal of two decayed mobile homes from the Lake Ponemah Mobile Home Park and granted a 30-day period to determine if another mobile home could be adequately rehabilitated.
10. Recessed the open meeting at 9:35 p.m.
11. Convened an Executive Session for the purpose of discussing pending litigation at 9:35 p.m.
12. Adjourned the Executive Session and reconvened the regular meeting at 10:05 p.m.
13. Adjourned at 10:05 p.m.
