BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS
SEPTEMBER 19, 2005

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday September 19, 2005 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Approved a motion to allow Trustee Goupil to abstain from voting on the law enforcement services agreement due to a conflict of interest.
4. Approved a law enforcement services contract with the Genesee County Sheriff Department.
5. Approved fire protection services agreements with Tyrone Township.
6. Adopted a revised Schedule of Fees.
7. Approved invoices for payment.
8. Adopted Resolution No. 2005-23, confirming the 2005 assessment roll for the Fenton Township Fire Protection Special Assessment District.
9. Adopted Ordinance No. 649, an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcels 06-27-100-004 and 06-27-100-015 (3472 & 3772 Silver Lake Road) from C-2 to PUD.
10. Adopted Ordinance No. 650, an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to define the use Light Fabrication and designate the zoning districts in which the use will be permitted.
11. Adopted Resolution No. 2005-22, authorizing Lake Fenton High School to apply for the necessary permit from the Genesee County Road Commission to conduct a homecoming parade along North Long Lake Road on Friday October 7, 2005.
12. Re-appointed David Franz, Thomas Richard and Dennis Schaefer to the Fenton Township Construction Board of Appeals for the term ending September 30, 2007.
13. Approved 2005 property tax roll special levies for Mosquito Control and Garbage Collection and special assessment levies for Private Road Maintenance and Street Lighting.
14. Adjourned at 9:10 p.m.
