

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON**  
**BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS**  
**OCTOBER 17, 2005**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday October 17, 2005 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Authorized the creation of a committee to review the relationships between the Fenton Township Board, Loose Senior Citizen Center and Southern Lakes Parks & Recreation.
4. Tabled until 11/7/05 a proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to rezone approximately 116 acres located southwest of the intersection of Fenton and Thompson Roads from AG and R-3 to PUD.
5. Adopted Ordinance No. 651, an amendatory ordinance to update the penalty provision language for Ordinances 151, 158, 161, 170, 183, 236, 237, 250, 260, 263, 264, 265, 276, 333, 400, 312 & 403.
6. Granted final approval for the plat of McCully Lake Estates No. 2.
7. Accepted, with regrets, the resignation of Sandra Carlson as the Planning Commission representative on the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals.
8. Appointed William Ochodnicky as the Planning Commission representative on the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals.
9. Scheduled a public hearing on the 2006 Fenton Township Budget.
10. Adopted Resolution No. 2005-25 endorsing the position of the Genesee County Drain Commissioner and opposing a lawsuit filed by several Genesee County school districts.
11. Adjourned at 9:35 p.m.
