**BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS**  
**JUNE 19, 2006**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday June 19, 2006 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as presented.
3. Received a presentation of Fenton Township's audited financial statements for the year ended 12/31/05 from Plante & Moran, LLP.
4. Approved invoices for payment.
5. Directed the Township Attorney to contact the Genesee County Road Commission regarding the status of the Torrey Road/Lahring Road intersection.
6. Adopted Ordinance No. 659, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise the legal description on a previously approved PUD rezoning for parcels 06-27-100-004 & 06-27-100-015, (3472 Allen's Landing).
7. Adopted Ordinance No. 660, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise conditions of a previously approved PUD rezoning for parcels 06-13-100-007 & 06-12-300-013, (east side of Fenton Road across from Log Cabin Point).
8. Adopted Ordinance No. 661, an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcels 06-03-300-003 & 06-10-100-018, (south side of Thompson Road east of Jennings Road), from AG and/or RMH, R-3 and C-3 to PUD.
9. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Grading Ordinance.
10. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment regarding conditional rezoning.
11. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment regarding special use permits.
12. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment regarding definitions.
13. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment regarding off-street parking requirements.
14. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment regarding zoning of freeways and expressways.
15. Approved the placement of temporary signs for the Linden Summer Happening event.
16. Granted tentative approval for the Preliminary Plat of Hunters Pointe.
17. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-15, endorsing and establishing the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as the standard for incident management for the Township.
18. Approved the solicitation of solid waste collection proposals for the years 2008-2010.
19. Approved revised committee appointments for the Township Board.
20. Adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
