

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON**  
**BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS**  
**SEPTEMBER 5, 2006**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Tuesday September 5, 2006 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as presented.
3. Approved invoices for payment.
4. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-36 confirming the revised special assessment roll for the Lake Ponemah Improvement Special Assessment District.
5. Conducted a public hearing and first reading of a proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcels 06-02-100-001, 06-02-100-002 and 06-02-100-003, (northeast corner of Torrey and Thompson Roads), from C-2 and R-3 to PUD.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-37, honoring Peter R. Matta for his years of service on the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals.
7. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-38, supporting the application of Lake Fenton Youth Tackle Football, Inc. for a non-profit gaming license from the State of Michigan for the purpose of conducting a fund raising raffle.
8. Defeated a motion to allow Trustee Goupil to abstain from voting on the lake access issue for certain lots in the Lakeside Acres subdivision.
9. Approved a motion to determine that lots 19-27 of the Lakeside Acres subdivision, but virtue of their exclusive rights to Pamella Park, have riparian access to Loon Lake, provided that existing wetlands and conservation areas are not encroached upon, and to direct the Zoning Administrator not to enforce private deed restrictions regarding said properties.
10. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-39, authorizing the Township Supervisor and Clerk to execute an agreement with the Genesee County Road Commission with regard to the project to pave Loon Lake Court.
11. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-40, scheduling a public hearing on the 2006 Fenton Township Fire Protection Special Assessment Roll.
12. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-41, directing the Township Clerk to publish a notice of intent regarding the issuance of \$20 million in bonds to fund sewer system improvements.
13. Adjourned at 11:55 p.m.
