The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday October 16, 2006 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as presented.
3. Approved invoices for payment.
4. Conducted a public needs hearing for the 2007 Community Development Block Grant Program
5. Adopted Ordinance No. 674, an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to amend the PUD conditions and conceptual plan for parcel 06-11-200-024, (2181 North Long Lake Road).
6. Conducted the first reading of a proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to rezone parcel 06-13-300-007, (south end of Wenwood Parkway), from C-2 to R-3.
7. Appointed Les Scott as the Fenton Township representative on the Loose Senior Citizen Center Board of Directors.
8. Approved the division of parcel 06-33-501-014, (Lot #14 of Island View Estates, located at 4379 Island View Drive), as requested.
9. Appointed Randall Thompson to the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals for the term ending November 30, 2007.
10. Approved a 4-year employment agreement for Operations Manager Thomas Broecker.
11. Approved 2006/2007 Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the Genesee County Sheriff Department.
12. Approved a cable EG Fees Funding Agreement for Fenton Area Public Schools.
13. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-44, identifying sources of funds for 2007 sewer bond payment obligations.
14. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-45, opposing Ballot Proposal 06-05 regarding mandatory school funding levels.
15. Adjourned at 9:50 p.m.
