The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday December 4, 2006 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-54, honoring the Lake Fenton High School football team for their outstanding season.
4. Approved invoices for payment.
5. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-50, confirming the special assessment roll for the Hidden Ridge III Street Lighting Special Assessment District.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-51, a General Appropriations Act resolution to formally adopt the 2007 Fenton Township budget.
7. Approved private road maintenance and street lighting special assessments, and miscellaneous levies for 2006.
8. Approved a GIS services agreement for 2007 with North Arrow Technologies, Inc.
9. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-52, honoring Alberta Martin for her years of service on the Southern Lakes Parks & Recreation Board of Directors.
10. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-53, honoring Rick Selley for his years of service on the Southern Lakes Parks & Recreation Board of Directors.
11. Adopted Resolution No. 2006-55, accepting petitions and setting the date for a public hearing on the creation of a special assessment district for the Springfield Hills condominium development.
12. Approved a motion to allow the abandoned right-of-way of Front Street, in the plat of Case's Island, to revert to the adjacent landowners.
13. Adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
