The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday November 19, 2007 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Approved invoices for payment.
4. Conducted the first reading of a proposed new Sign Regulation Ordinance.
5. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to designate commercial recreational uses as uses permitted by Special Use Permit.
6. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance to establish side setback requirements in the OS, C-1, C-2 and C-3 zoning districts.
7. Adopted Resolution No. 2007-36, identifying the sources of funds to pay 2008 sewer bond debt obligations.
8. Re-appointed James R. Cady to the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals for the term ending November 30, 2010.
9. Re-appointed Leslie D. Scott to the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals for the term ending November 30, 2010.
10. Appointed K.C. Baran to the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals for the term ending November 30, 2010.
11. Appointed James D. McGuirk as an alternate member of the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals for the term ending November 30, 2010.
12. Approved a 2008 GIS services agreement with North Arrow Technologies, Inc.
13. Adopted Resolution No. 2007-37, opposing the concept of a county-wide fire authority.
14. Schedule a public hearing for December 3, 2007 to review the proposed 2008 Fenton Township budget.
15. Adopted Resolution No. 2007-38, a memorial resolution for former Township Trustee Betty Anne Wolfe.
16. Adjourned at 9:05 p.m.
