

**PUBLIC NOTICE

SEPTEMBER 8, 2009**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Tuesday September 8, 2009 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Approved invoices & expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$392,608.97.
4. Adopted Ordinance No. 714, a new ordinance regulating dangerous buildings.
5. Approved a final assessment for the parcels in the Wenwood Drive and Wendell Drive Road Improvement Special Assessment District.
6. Approved a local road improvement project to construct ditches along Hogan Road between Silver Lake Road and Rolston Road.
7. Adopted a revised Fenton Township Schedule of Fees.
8. Adopted Resolution No. 2009-28, setting the date for a public hearing on the 2009 Fenton Township Fire Protection Special Assessment Roll.
9. Postponed action on a proposed petition to the Genesee County Drain Commissioner to establish a drainage district for the Pine Lake area.
10. Adopted Resolution No. 2009-30, authorizing Lake Fenton High School to apply for a permit from the Genesee County Road Commission to conduct their annual homecoming parade along Torrey Road between North Long Lake and Lahring Roads on 9/25/09.
11. Adjourned the regular meeting at 8:30 p.m. to convene an executive session for the purpose of reviewing a proposed collective bargaining agreement with the Fenton Township Employees Union.
12. Reconvened the regular meeting at 8:45 p.m.
13. Approved a collective bargaining agreement with the Fenton Township Employees Union.
14. Adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
