2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Approved invoices & expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$239,110.78.
4. Conducted a public hearing on the proposed 2010 Fenton Township Budget.
5. Adopted Resolution No. 2009-39, formally adopting the 2010 Fenton Township Budget.
6. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment regarding the review process for Special Use Permits.
7. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to add language regarding wind energy systems.
8. Conducted the first reading of a proposed amendment to the Sign Regulation Ordinance to add language regarding digital signs.
9. Approved a 2010 GIS Services Agreement with North Arrow Technologies, Inc.
10. Appointed Trustee Robert Kesler, Treasurer John Tucker and resident Vince Lorraine to the Genesee County Metropolitan Alliance as Fenton Township's primary representative, alternate representative and citizen representative, respectively.
11. Appointed Kim Procnier to the Fenton Township Dangerous Buildings Board of Appeals for the term ending December 31, 2012.
12. Appointed Brad Hissong and Chris Weir to the Fenton Township Dangerous Buildings Board of Appeals for the term ending December 31, 2011.
13. Appointed John Shayna and Jack Darnell to the Fenton Township Dangerous Buildings Board of Appeals for the term ending December 31, 2010.
