1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as amended.
3. Approved invoices & expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$160,926.76.
4. Adopted Ordinance No. 724, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone part of parcel 06-18-200-005, (6159 Lahring Road), from R-3 to AG.
5. Adopted Ordinance No. 725, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise language regulating public boat access sites.
6. Adopted Ordinance No. 726, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise language regulating restaurant outdoor seating and parking requirements.
7. Re-appointed Sandra K. Carlson to the Fenton Township Planning Commission for the term ending May 31, 2013.
8. Adopted Resolution No. 2010-20, authorizing the issuance of \$990,000 in capital improvement bonds to fund road construction and township facility improvements.
9. Adopted Resolution No. 2010-21, authorizing the National Multiple Sclerosis Society to apply to the Genesee County Road Commission for a permit to hold a bicycling event within the right-of-way of Lahring Road on July 17-18, 2010.
10. Adopted Resolution No. 2010-22, establishing the Fenton Township Retiree Health Care Fund Trust.
11. Adopted Resolution No. 2010-23, setting the July Board of Review meeting date for July 21, 2010.
12. Adopted amendments to the 2010 Fenton Township Budget.
