The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday September 19, 2011 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Approved the agenda as presented.
3. Approved invoices & expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$704,520.41.
4. Adopted Resolution No. 2011-11, confirming a new special assessment roll for the Pine Lake Improvement Special Assessment District.
5. Conducted a public hearing on a proposed special assessment roll for the Loon Lake Improvement Special Assessment District.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2011-13, confirming the 2011 Fenton Township Fire Protection Special Assessment Roll.
7. Adopted Ordinance No. 739, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise provisions regarding Public Utility Buildings and Uses.
8. Adopted Ordinance No. 740, an amendment to the Open Burning Regulation Ordinance.
9. Adopted Resolution No. 2011-14, supporting the request from Emily's Helping Hand Foundation that they be recognized as a nonprofit organization for the purpose of obtaining a charitable gaming license from the State of Michigan.
10. Adopted Resolution No. 2011-15, authorizing Lake Fenton High School to apply for a permit from the Genesee County Road Commission to conduct their annual homecoming parade along Torrey Road between North Long Lake Road and Lahring Road on 10/7/11.
11. Adopted Resolution No. 2011-16, authorizing accelerated foreclosure proceedings for tax delinquent properties that are determined to be abandoned.
