2. Approved the agenda as presented.
3. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$799,086.69.
4. Received the third quarter report from Ordinance Enforcement Officer Robert Atkinson.
5. Adopted Ordinance No. 759, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise language relating to telecommunications towers.
6. Accepted the resignation of Deputy Assessor James N. Glascock, effective October 25, 2013.
7. Adopted Resolution No. 2013-22, designating the sources of funds to meet 2014 bond debt payment obligations for sewer bonds issued by the Genesee County Drain Commissioner.
8. Adopted amendments to the 2013 Fenton Township budget.
9. Adjourned at 8:20 p.m.
