BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS  
SEPTEMBER 22, 2014**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday September 22, 2014 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
2. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
3. Approved the agenda as presented.
4. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$192,120.66.
5. Adopted Resolution No. 2014-23, confirming the special assessment roll for the Latourette Drive Road Improvement Special Assessment District.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2014-24 and No. 2014-25, creating the Lake Fenton Improvement Special Assessment District and setting the date for a public hearing on the special assessment roll.
7. Adopted Resolution No. 2014-26, confirming a new 5-year special assessment roll for the Byram Lake Improvement Special Assessment District.
8. Adopted Resolution No. 2014-27, confirming a new 5-year special assessment roll for the Loon Lake Improvement Special Assessment District.
9. Adopted Resolution No. 2014-28, confirming the 2014 Fenton Township Fire Protection special assessment roll.
10. Conducted a community needs hearing for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.
11. Approved the submission of a CDBG project application for road ditching and driveway culvert replacement for portions of Odell Road and Jennings Road.
12. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone parcel 06-11-537-026 (2273 Sonora Drive) from C-2 to R-5.
13. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise language regarding nonconforming structures.
14. Conducted the first reading of a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to revise language regarding height requirements for communication tower equipment structures.
15. Scheduled a public hearing for October 6, 2014 to consider the application of CMI-Schneible Company to transfer existing Industrial Facilities Exemption Certificates from the City of Saginaw to Fenton Township.
16. Approved a Genesee County Road Commission proposal for gravel resurfacing of Hogan Road from Rolston Road to the railroad tracks
17. Recessed the regular meeting at 9:10 p.m. for the purpose of convening an Executive Session to discuss the proposed sale of township-owned real estate.
18. Reconvened the regular meeting at 9:16 p.m.
19. Approved the sale of tax-foreclosed real estate to Odyssey Investment Group LLC.
20. Adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
