1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Clerk Krug led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Appointed Clerk Krug as temporary Chairman.
4. Approved the agenda as presented.
5. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$283,349.72.
6. Received 2016 4th quarter and annual fire department report from Fire Chief Ryan Volz.
7. Approved 2017 summer tax collection agreements with Linden Community Schools, Fenton Area Public Schools and Genesee Intermediate School District.
8. Adopted the 2017 Fenton Township Property Tax Financial Hardship Exemption Policy.
9. Granted a two-year extension for the tentative approval of the Preliminary Plat of Pinnacle Shores.
10. Scheduled a public hearing for January 23, 2017 to obtain citizen input regarding potential local road improvement projects for 2017.
