The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday April 23, 2018 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$401,556.98.
4. Received the first quarter fire department report from Ordinance Enforcement Officer Pat Shaw.
5. Authorized a letter of support committing \$192,150.00 in the year 2021 toward the replacement of the Hogan Road bridge over the Shiawassee River.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2018-08, declaring intent to issue capital improvement bonds to fund sewer system improvements and authorizing the publication of the required notice of intent.
7. Adopted amendments to the 2018 Fenton Township Budget.
8. Approved an extension of the real estate broker services agreement with Ed Constable to October 30, 2018.
9. Adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
