

**PUBLIC NOTICE

JULY 9, 2018**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday July 9, 2018 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$661,093.88.
4. Received the second quarter report from Ordinance Enforcement Officer Patrick Shaw.
5. Adopted Ordinance No. 802, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone part of parcel 06-07-400-003, (12441 Sharp Road), from R-1 to R-3.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2018-15, scheduling a public hearing on a proposed street improvement special assessment district for Four Lakes Avenue, West Four Lakes Drive, Sadler Drive, Squaw Lake Drive and Isleview Drive.
7. Recessed the open meeting at 7:53 p.m. to convene a closed session on possible litigation.
8. Reconvened the open meeting at 9:27 p.m.
9. Scheduled a special meeting for July 25, 2018 to conduct a disciplinary hearing regarding allegations within the Fenton Township Fire Department.
10. Placed two members of the Fenton Township Fire Department on paid administrative leave, pending a disciplinary hearing.
11. Adjourned at 10:25 p.m.
