The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday December 3, 2018 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$306,442.79.
4. Conducted a public hearing on the proposed 2019 Fenton Township Budget.
5. Adopted Resolution No. 2018-44, formally adopting the 2019 Fenton Township Budget.
6. Approved a motion to tentatively terminate the Aquatic Nuisance Plant Control contract for Lake Ponemah treatments, pending a review by the Township Attorney.
7. Re-appointed Trustee Robert Kesler to the Southern Lakes Parks & Recreation Board of Directors for the term ending December 31, 2021.
8. Approved an employment agreement for Zoning Administrator Michael C. Deem.
9. Approved a 2019 GIS services agreement with North Arrow Technologies, Inc.
10. Approved a 2019-20 Law Enforcement Services Agreement with the Genesee County Sheriff Department.
11. Accepted, with deep regret, the resignation of Lieutenant Scott Cole from the Fenton Township Fire Department.
12. Adjourned at 8:57 p.m.
