The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday February 4, 2019 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Clerk Krug led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Appointed Clerk Krug as temporary chairman.
4. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$327,308.10.
5. Denied a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone parcel 06-12-100-013, (12201 Fenton Road), from AG to C-2.
6. Adopted Ordinance No. 805, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone parcel 06-03-200-014, (11220 Torrey Road), from R-3 to M-2, with conditions.
7. Adopted Resolution No. 2019-03, supporting the application of the Lake Fenton Property Owners Association to participate in the MDNR Canada Goose Egg & Nest Destruction Program for the years 2019 through 2023.
8. Adopted Resolution No. 2019-04, supporting the application of the Lake Fenton Property Owners Association to participate in the MDNR Mute Swan Egg & Nest Destruction Program for the years 2019 through 2023.
9. Denied a motion to adopt a resolution supporting the application of the Lake Fenton Property Owners Association to participate in the MDNR Mute Swan Removal Program.
10. Appointed Trustee Christine Reid as a Fenton Township representative on the Southern Lakes Parks & Recreation Board of Directors for the term ending December 31, 2021.
11. Adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
