3. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$383,304.12.
4. Adopted Ordinance No. 614-19, an updated Vehicle Code Ordinance.
5. Approved Genesee County Road Commission cost estimates for three local road improvement projects.
6. Adopted updated documents in compliance with the Michigan Freedom of Information Act.
7. Granted tentative approval for the Preliminary Plat of Silver Landings No. 3, subject to the approval of all required county, state and federal agencies.
8. Adopted the 2019 Law Day Proclamation - "Free Speech, Free Press, Free Society".
9. Adjourned at 8:18 p.m.
