

**PUBLIC NOTICE
CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON
BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS
JUNE 17, 2019**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday June 17, 2019 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Supervisor Mathis led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$364,319.54.
4. After conducting a public hearing on same, adopted Resolution No. 2019-17, confirming the special assessment roll for Byram Lake Improvement Special Assessment District No. 2.
5. After conducting a public hearing on same, adopted Resolution No. 2019-18, confirming the special assessment roll for the Eleanor Street Improvement Special Assessment District.
6. After continuing a public hearing on same, adopted Resolution No. 2019-16, confirming the special assessment roll for the Four Lakes Street Improvement Special Assessment District.
7. Adopted Resolution No. 2019-19, authorizing the issuance of up to \$618,000 in special assessment bonds to finance the Four Lakes Street Improvement Special Assessment project.
8. Approved a Genesee County Road Commission Cost Authorization form for the Eleanor Street project, with a total cost of \$140,475.00.
9. Adopted resolution No. 2019-20, scheduling a public hearing on the creation of a street improvement special assessment district for the Silver Ridge subdivision.
10. Appointed Philip M. Lewis to the Fenton Township Planning Commission for the term ending May 31, 2022.
11. Approved the termination of a member of the Fenton Township Fire Department for failure to meet the minimum monthly alarm response requirements.
12. Approved a motion to offer the option of resigning his officer position and remain employed as a firefighter to a member of the Fenton Township Fire Department due to failure to meet the minimum monthly alarm response requirements.
13. Adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
