The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday December 2, 2019 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Clerk Krug led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Appointed Clerk Krug as temporary chairman.
4. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$24,276.47.
5. Conducted a public hearing on the proposed 2020 Fenton Township Budget.
6. Adopted Resolution No. 2019-51, formally adopting the 2020 Fenton Township Budget.
7. Adopted Resolution No. 2019-52, honoring recently retired employee Leeandra "Andy" Badgley.
8. Approved a 4-month extension of the existing license agreement with the Genesee County Parks & Recreation Commission for the use and maintenance of park property, commonly known as the Deer Run Soccer Complex.
9. Approved a 4-month extension of the existing sub-license agreement with AYSO Region 417 for the use and maintenance of park property, commonly known as the Deer Run Soccer Complex.
10. Adjourned at 7:58 p.m.
