BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS  
NOVEMBER 9, 2020**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday November 9, 2020 via telephone conference call and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Approved the agenda as presented.
3. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$553,800.32.
4. Conducted a public hearing on, and first reading of, a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone parcel 06-11-527-029, (vacant land on Bowles Street), from R-5 to PUD, with additional conditions, to be added to the Gables of North Shore condominium for the purpose of constructing accessory buildings.
5. Conducted a public hearing on, and first reading of, a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone part of parcel 06-291-200-007, (vacant land adjacent to Price's Airport on Silver Lake Road), to create a new PUD project for the development of a senior assisted living facility.
6. Approved a motion to continue the optional 80/20 rules for 2021 to comply with the Publicly Funded Health Insurance Contribution Act, Public Act 152 of 2011.
7. Re-appointed Melissa Farney and Pete Matta to the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals for the term ending November 30, 2023.
8. Adjourned at 8:48 p.m.
