

**PUBLIC NOTICE
CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON
BOARD MEETING SYNOPSIS
AUGUST 30, 2021**

The Fenton Township Board held a regular meeting on Monday August 30, 2021 at the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, 12060 Mantawauka Drive, Fenton, Michigan, and took the following actions.

1. Trustee Goupil offered the opening prayer.
2. Supervisor Lorraine led the pledge of allegiance to the flag.
3. Approved the agenda as presented.
4. Approved invoices and expenditures for payment in the total amount of \$152,323.89.
5. After conducted a public hearing on same, adopted Resolution No. 2021-23, creating the Cottage Cove Erosion Control Improvement Special Assessment District, and Resolution No. 2021-24, scheduling a public hearing on the special assessment roll at the September 20, 2021 Township Board meeting.
6. After conducted a public hearing on same, adopted Resolution No. 2021-25, creating Pine Lake Improvement Special Assessment District No. 2, and Resolution No. 2021-26, scheduling a public hearing on the special assessment roll at the September 20, 2021 Township Board meeting.
7. After conducted a public hearing on same, adopted Resolution No. 2021-27, confirming a revised special assessment roll for Loon Lake Improvement Special Assessment District No. 2.
8. Adopted Ordinance No. 827, a Zoning Ordinance amendment to define the uses *Brewpub*, *Small Distiller* and *Winery*, and to permit those uses by special use permit in the C-1, C-2 and C-3 zoning districts.
9. Introduced proposed amendments to the Land Division Ordinance, Lot Partition Ordinance and Subdivision Control Ordinance to revise, update and clarify language relating to land divisions and related measurements.
10. Approved the sale of tax-reverted property to Stephen Diller, subject to a right of reverter clause.
11. Approved three sewer infrastructure projects to be funded by ARPA grant funds, subject to receipt of said grant funds.
12. Approved a 1-year contract extension with APM Mosquito Control.
13. Adopted Resolution No. 2021-28, scheduling a public hearing on the 2021 Fenton Township Fire Protection special assessment roll to be held at the September 20, 2021 Township Board meeting.
14. Adopted Resolution No. 2021-29, a memorial resolution for former Fenton Township Board member Daniel E. Rust.
15. Adjourned at 8:27 p.m.
