

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON
Ordinance No. 634
Adopted February 21, 2005

An ordinance to amend Article V of Sewer System Ordinance No. 615 for the purpose of prohibiting parking or placing obstructions near sewer pump stations.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON, GENESEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN
ORDAINS:

ARTICLE I. Section 5 of Article V of Ordinance No. 615 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

SECTION 5. Manholes and Pump Stations

- A. No person shall remove a manhole cover from a Township Sewer without also first obtaining written approval therefore from the Township.
- B. No person shall bury, cover or otherwise obstruct access to any manhole on the Township Sewer. In the event that a Township Sewer manhole is found to be buried or covered, the Township shall take immediate action to uncover and/or raise said manhole to the appropriate grade. The owner of the property on which the manhole is located shall be responsible for any and all costs associated with the action taken by the Township to uncover and/or raise the manhole.
- C. No person shall park any vehicle or place any object in a manner that blocks or impedes vehicular access to a sewer pump station.

ARTICLE II. Severability.

Each and every article of this amendatory ordinance, and each provision of each article section and subsection is declared to be separable and severable, and a judicial determination that any article, section, subsection or provision of this ordinance is invalid or unenforceable, shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other article, section, subsection or provision.

ARTICLE III. Effective Date.

This amendatory ordinance shall be published as required by law and shall take effect immediately after its enactment and publication.
