

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON
Ordinance No. 761
Adopted: March 17, 2014

An ordinance to amend Section 4 of Wild, Dangerous and Vicious Animals Ordinance No. 655 to revise language related to enforcement and penalties.

ARTICLE I. Section 4 (Enforcement and Penalties) of Ordinance No. 655 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

SECTION 4. Enforcement and Penalties

Violations of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor, which shall be punishable upon conviction by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. Each day a violation continues shall be considered a separate offense. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the Township from taking such other lawful action as is necessary to prevent or remedy any violation.

ARTICLE II. This ordinance and its various articles, paragraphs and clauses thereof are hereby declared to be severable. If any article, paragraph or clause is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this amendatory ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

ARTICLE III. All ordinances and provisions of ordinances of the Charter Township of Fenton in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE IV. This amendatory ordinance shall be published as required by law and shall take effect immediately after adoption and publication.
