

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON
Ordinance No. 794
Adopted: June 5, 2017

An ordinance to repeal, in total, Ordinance No. 720 relating to medical marihuana, in consideration of the status of the laws in the State of Michigan, and for the general health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Charter Township of Fenton

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON, GENESEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION I. ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 720

Ordinance No. 720, regulating, growing, consuming and the distribution of marihuana is hereby repealed, revoked, and shall have no further force and effect.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY

Each and every article, section and subsection, of this ordinance, and each provision of each article, section and subsection, is declared to be separable and severable, and a judicial determination that any article, section, subsection or provision of this ordinance is invalid or unenforceable, shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other article, section, subsection or provision.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance is to take effect thirty (30) days after passage and publication hereof.
