

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON
PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

At their meeting of August 7, 2017 the Fenton Township Board conducted the first reading of the following proposed ordinance. The second reading of the proposed ordinance is scheduled to be held on Monday August 21, 2017, beginning at 7:30 p.m.

An ordinance to clarify, amend, and otherwise alter Ordinance No. 623, being that ordinance that deals with *Disorderly Conduct* within the confines of the Charter Township of Fenton, for the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Charter Township of Fenton.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF FENTON, GENESEE COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION I. SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 623

Section 2 of Ordinance No. 623, defining disorderly persons, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Number 25 of Section 2, dealing with the possession, consuming, growing, or cultivating of marihuana is hereby deleted, and of no further force and effect.
2. Number 26 of Section 2, dealing with the consumption of marihuana in a public place, is hereby deleted, and of no further force and effect.

SECTION II. REAFFIRMATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 623

We affirm and readopt any and all other provisions of said Ordinance No. 623, which are not amended or altered hereby.

SECTION III. SEVERABILITY

Each and every article, section and subsection, of this Ordinance, and each provision of each article, section and subsection, is declared to be separable and severable, and a judicial determination that any article, section, subsection or provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unenforceable, shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other article, section, subsection or provision.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective as soon as allowed by state law.
