Fenton Township Updating and Moving Forward Into 2024

Over the last year, there have been some physical changes to the Fenton Township Civic Community Center. The most notable of that being the remodel of the Fenton Township Hall.

Located in the lower level of the Fenton Township Civic Community Center, the Fenton Township Hall is the home of the Fenton Township Board, Planning Commission, and Zoning Board of Appeals Meetings. Often it is used for March Board of Review along with utilized for election business depending on the size of the election.

The Hall underwent its first updating in over 20 years in the spring of 2023. The newly renovated hall, highlights the floor to ceiling view of Lake Fenton, has an updated video and audio system that allows for the public to attend Township meetings virtually when they cannot make it in person.

The hall is also available for rental.

Not only is the hall a great location for a weekend family

reunion or wedding reception, it has seen an increase in rental reservations for business trainings and meetings during the week.

Another update was to the front desk area with a reconfiguration of desk and the installation of a register station that includes a card reader.

Card payment processing does include a 3% fee, that goes for online or in person as it is the same processing platform.

The new processing platform, Invoice Cloud, also allows for online payments to be scheduled or set to auto pay by residents when they set up an account on the platform.

Checks can also be used online to make payment with a \$3.00 flat rate processing fee.

Upcoming Property Tax Dates

February 29, 2024 - Deadline to pay 2023 property tax at Fenton Township.

March 1, 2024 - Payments for 2023 bills no longer accepted at the Township Office.

July 1, 2024 - Summer 2024 Available.

September 14, 2024 - Summer 2024 Due. Can still pay at the Township however, penalties and interest start accruing.

December 1, 2024 - Winter 2024 Available.

February 28, 2025 - Deadline to pay 2024 Property Taxes at Fenton Township.

2024 Election Dates and Information

2024 is here and there are several elections already on the calendar for Fenton Township voters.

February 27, 2024 - Michigan Presidential Primary Election

August 6, 2024 - Michigan State Primary Election

November 5, 2024 - General Election

Each of the three above mentioned election cycles are state and/or federal elections; thus, they will each include early voting. Early voting was a part of the 2022 proposal 2 ballot initiative that was passed by voters.

The Fenton Township Board adopted resolution No. 2023-47 at the November 6, 2023 meeting establishing the location and hours for early voting operations for statewide and federal elections in Fenton Township. The early voting site for Fenton Township is the Fenton Township Civic Community Center located at 12060 Mantawauka Drive.
