

Winter 2022 Property Tax

The Winter 2022 Property Taxes became available on December 1, 2022.

The 2022 taxes are due to the Fenton Township office by close of business on February 28, 2023.

Payment can be made via credit or debit card online on the Fenton Township website. There is no card reader at the Township Office. Payments of check or money order may be mailed in or dropped off at the Township Office either over the counter or in the after hours drop box. Cash payments are also accepted at the Township Office.

The Township Office will be closed for the holidays from Dec. 23-26 and Dec. 30-Jan 2.

Payments not made by close of business on Feb 28, 2023 will be rolled over to the Genesee County Treasurer's Office.
